The Two Trackers Four Wheel Drive Club is a family oriented, trail riding, non-profit organization. The Club holds a number of trail rides, forest clean ups and charitable events throughout the year including Adopt-A-Road Programs. All Club events are alcohol free for safety and legality. The Club is made stronger and more enjoyable by the volunteering and participation of its membership. Your involvement is necessary to continue our efforts in building a diverse library of trails, educating and demonstrating responsible off-road driving and preserving a network of trails for our use and the use for future generations.

The Club is not brand specific (i.e. Jeep™ only); all you need participate is a 4-wheel drive vehicle, a properly secured winch point on *both* ends of the vehicle, and common sense. Most events require the vehicle and driver to be street licensed and insured, as public roads often connect trail segments. There are many events around the state of Michigan (Drummond Island, Manistee National Forest, Silver Lake, The Mounds) and some out of state (Indiana, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Kentucky and Utah) including trips to Badlands Off-Road Park (Attica, IN).

The Club does not condone the use of “snatch straps” except for the most minor of extractions. Children are frequently in attendance and safety ***will not be compromised!*** Winching is slower but the additional safety afforded is beyond measure. A winch is not required for participation, but cannot be over recommended.

As an effort to build a stronger, common voice, our club pays membership fees to the national organizations of United Four Wheel Drive Associations, Great Lakes Four Wheel Drive Association and the Tread Lightly! Program. Newsletters from these national organizations and the Club are our and your means of staying informed. The Two Trackers have celebrated their 34th anniversary of being incorporated. The club was formed for the purposes of:

- Providing social, educational, and recreational activities for its membership
- Participation in, and support of, civic activities for the betterment of the community
- Promoting conservation for the betterment of the environment

The annually elected Board of Directors work diligently to address the desires of its membership.
